SYNOPSIS OF THE HEALTH MESSAGE

INTRO: This will be a brief synopsis of the Health Message. I will demonstrate evidence for healthy eating from Genesis to the New Earth and then return to answer objections.

- 1. **THE BEGINNING:** Genesis 1:29-30: God gave fruits and green herbs (vegetables) for food
- Their diet was completely plant-based. There was no death and hence no flesh eating.
- Genesis 9:3: Only after the flood does meat become a part of man's diet. All vegetation was destroyed.
- Age decreases after meat was introduced into your diet SEE TIMELINE
- 2. Exodus 16: God dictates their diet
- Verse 3: The people ask for the meats and bread of Egypt Verse 4: But God gives them only bread (verse 4).
- **Deut**: God promises not to bring any of the diseases of Egypt upon them.
- The Egyptians were known for dying of all kinds of diseases.
- Was God concerned both with their mental and physical health?
- **Numbers 11:32-34:** They desired the meat of Egypt, God would punish them in a month after eating it (verse 20).
- God brought upon them the promised discipline more quickly than originally stated (verse 33) for being gluttons.
- The meat was Quail, which was a CLEAN MEAT.
- Leviticus 11: God restricts their diet.
- 3. Jesus ate clean meat
- To be clear, Jesus did eat animal flesh.
- Mark 14:12-14 and Luke 24:42-43: But it was CLEAN meat (Passover lamb, fish).
- Jesus was also circumcised.
- Jesus is currently in heaven where there is no death if he eats there, it will not be meat.
- 4. Jesus did not do away with dietary laws
- Acts 10:14: All his time with Jesus, he never understood Him to have done away with diet restrictions.
- Thus, dietary restrictions continued until after the cross.
- CONTEXT: Read Acts 10:9-16,
 - A. Verse 15: Peter saw the vision three times Verse 19: suddenly three people came seeking Peter.
 - B. Verse 14: Don't call any foods common or unclean Verse 28: Don't call any man common or unclean
- Hence the vision was not about food but about humans and the gospel reaching the Gentiles also.

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Truth is always progr	ressive
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- Proverbs 4:18: "The path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day."
- 2 Peter 1:12: There is truth, then there is "present" truth. The following examples were truths for their times:
 - A. The message by Noah of the upcoming deluge (Gen. 6).
 - B. The impending destruction of Nineveh at the preaching on Jonah (Jonah 1:2).
 - C. The Sacrificial system which ceased at the death of Christ on the cross (Daniel 9:27).
 - D. The civil laws of ancient Israel including the death penalty, slavery laws, etc.
 - E. Ceremonial laws like feasts days which found their fulfillment when Christ came (1 Cor. 5:7).
- 6. God's people to be healthy today
- 3 John 2: Prosper and be in health / Animal products today are not the same as animal products in the past.
- W.H.O. designates all processed meats as cancerous / Mad cow disease, bird flu, salmonella
- 7. Extreme circumstances allowed
- THE FLOOD: Is an example of when under extreme/unfortunate circumstances, restrictions can be removed.
- Romans 14:17: "The kingdom of God is neither meat nor drinks, but righteousness and peace and joy..."
- Foods should NEVER get in the way of the preaching of the gospel
- Although foods should not be a test question, each individual is responsible for their body (
- 8. **THE END:** Back to the original diet
- Isaiah 66:17: In the end, God is still concerned with His people eating unclean meats.
- **Revelation 19:9:** "marriage supper" will this include dead flesh? / **Revelation 22:1-2:** Tree of life restored.
